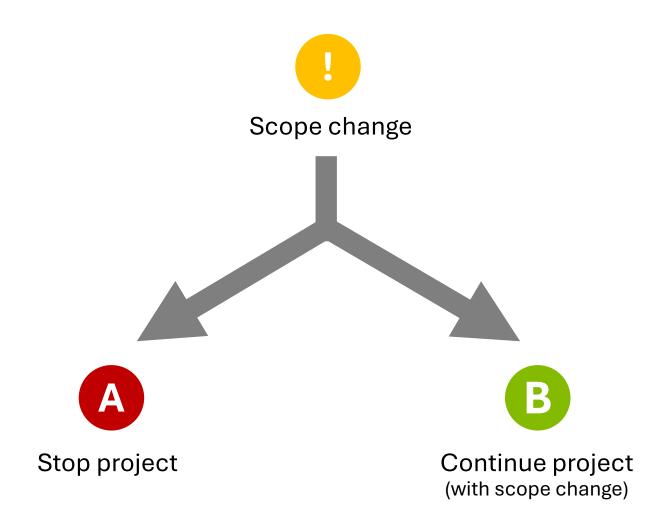

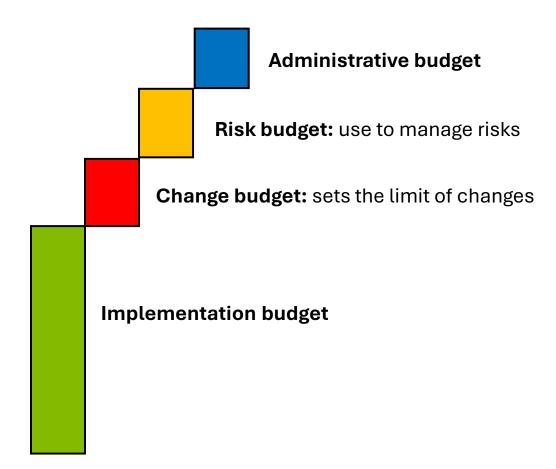
Introduction



Al is a new technology, and scope changes are inevitable. How do you plan for the unexpected, without risking to stop the project (which always should be the default when scope changes occur).



The project budget



There are four parts of a budget for a project:

Implementation budget The estimation of the actual implementation that is done

when planning based on the knowledge at the time.

Change budget The amount the project can spend on changes to the project

scope.

Risk budget The amount the project can spend on managing risks that

occur during the project.

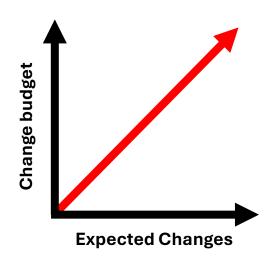
Administrative budget The estimation of administrative task, such as project

management, change management and technical lead.

New technology = need of high change budget

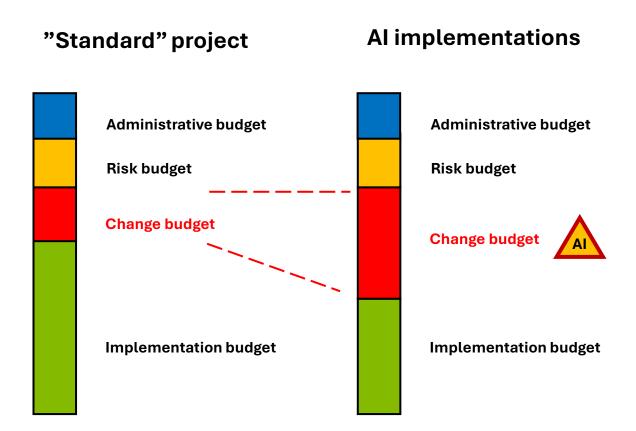
New technology evolves fast. When implementing new technology, one must be aware that scope changes are inevitable - you must plan for the unexpected.

To plan ahead for scope changes, the change budget is the part of the budget that will be affected. The more expected changes the larger change budget you need.



Al affects the budget

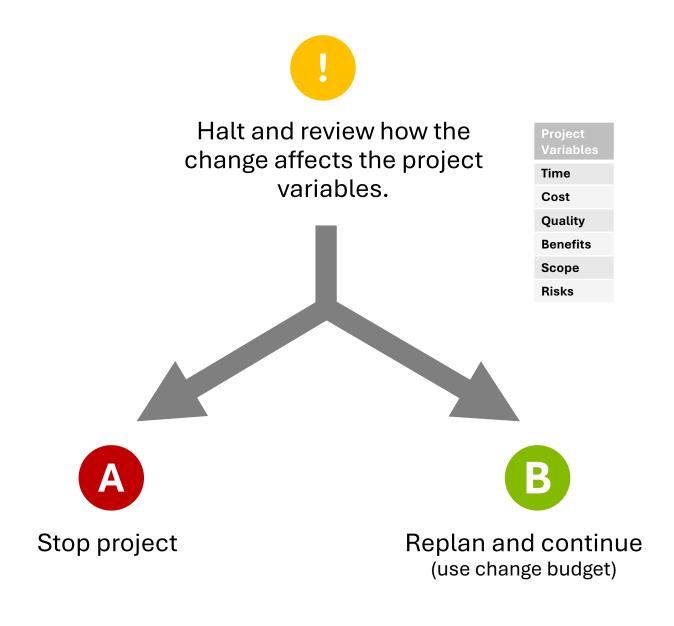
Al is a new technology, and this must be taken to account when setting up the budget. Compared to a "standard" project the change budget must be increased, to meet up for unplanned changes (such as release of new functionality or altered functionality of a service that was in scope).



When scope changes happens.

When there is a scope change, the project should be halted and a review of how the change affects the project variables must be performed.

The default way to take is always to stop the project, but if there is enough in the change budget to handle the change the plan can be revised and the project continue.





Conclusion

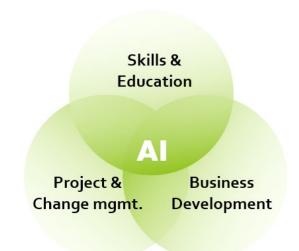
Al is a new technology, and this must be taken to account when setting up the budget. Start Al projects with a high change budget to manage inevitable scope changes instead of stopping the project.
